

Qualifications for Nominees to the PBA Board of Examiners and Board of Accreditors:

- Certified Diplomate of the PBA for at least 10 years
- Holder of a Continuing Demonstration of Qualification (CDQ) in Anesthesiology
- In active clinical practice in anesthesiology and/or related subspecialties
- Member in good standing of both the Philippine Society of Anesthesiologists (PSA) and the Philippine Medical Association (PMA)
- Not currently serving as Chairperson or Training Officer of any anesthesia residency program
- May come from private practice in PBA-accredited training centers and/or academic medical centers
- Must submit at least five (5) Higher-Order Thinking Skills (HOTS) questions in basic anesthesia
- Nominated by another PBA Diplomate or may self-nominate
- Must consent to the nomination
- Must provide three (3) references with complete contact information

Additional points will be given to candidates who meet the following criteria:

- Past Chairperson or Training Officer of a residency training program for at least three (3) years
- Holder of an NTTC certificate of attendance in Education and Test Construction
- Faculty member of a medical school or has relevant teaching experience
- Holder of a master's degree in education
