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**PBA Written Examination (Written Clinical Exam)**

The PBA Written Examination (Written Clinical Exam) will be focused on the application of anesthesia principles to clinical settings. This is comprised of 200 MCQs covering various clinical disciplines.

- **Schedule and Manner of Administration**

- When: April 2025
- How: Face-to-Face

- **Qualification Requirements**

- Fully accomplished application form
- Certificate (Diploma) of completion of 36 months of residency training in Anesthesiology
- Minimum of at least 1,000 APPROVED points regardless of service or technique case mix

Entries that are currently in the SUBMITTED status will be converted to an APPROVED status upon submission and verification of certified true copy of anesthesia records to the PBA secretariat. Soft copies will be accepted for as long as it is legible. Soft copies need not necessarily employ a scanning machine. Photograph with a clear resolution containing the entire document is already admissible.

**SPECIAL NOTE:**

For those who will graduate by 2025, this requirement will be:

Minimum of at least 1,000 APPROVED points with at least 500 primary points with complete case mix for both service and technique categories.

- Must have taken three (3) Resident's In-Training Examinations (RITE)
- Notarized Acknowledgement, Release and Quit Claim (Form is provided by PBA.)
- A letter of recommendation or certificate of ethical professional behavior from any two (2) of the following: Chair of the Department, Training Officer or bonafide DPBA who can attest that no case of non-ethical behavior is known to have been filed against the candidate.

- Certification of membership in good standing for the current year from the Philippine Society of Anesthesiologists (national)
- One copy of 2" x 2" picture
- Photocopy of current PRC ID card
- **Submission of Application**
  - A completed PBA application form must be submitted to signify the intentions of the resident graduate to take the Clinical Written Exam.  
  
In terms of the application form, there is no need to fill out another application form if you already filled-out the application form when you applied for any of the prior Written examinations.
  - The deadline for submission of application is on **April 7, 2025**.

- **General Conditions**

- It is a MUST to pass the Written Clinical Exam. Each applicant will be given three (3) attempts to pass the Written Clinical Exam.
- Applicants who fail the Written Clinical Exam three (3) times shall need to:
  - take the next RITE prior to application to sit for the next Written Clinical Exam
- In order to qualify for the Oral Examination, the applicant must have passed both the Written Basic and Clinical Examinations.
