PBA Written Examination (Clinical Written Exam)

The PBA Written Examination (Clinical Written Exam) will be focused on the application of anesthesia principles to clinical settings. This is comprised of 200 MCQs covering various clinical disciplines.

- **Schedule and Manner of Administration**

- When: April 19, 2026
- How: Face-to-Face

- **Qualification Requirements**

- Fully accomplished application form.

Please note that candidates need to complete only one application form, which shall remain valid up to the Practical Examination.

- A certificate attesting to the official completion of 36 months of residency training, clearly indicating the successful completion of training and the inclusive dates covered.
- Minimum of at least 1,000 APPROVED points with at least 500 primary points with COMPLETE case mix for both service and technique categories.
- Must have taken three (3) Resident's In-Training Examinations (RITE)
- Notarized Acknowledgement, Release and Quit Claim (Form is provided by PBA.)
- A letter of recommendation or certificate of ethical professional behavior from any two (2) of the following: Chair of the Department, Training Officer or bonafide DPBA who can attest that no case of non-ethical behavior is known to have been filed against the candidate.
- Certification of membership in good standing for the current year from the Philippine Society of Anesthesiologists (National)
- One copy of 2" x 2" picture
- Photocopy of current PRC ID card

- **Submission of application**

A completed PBA **Application Form** must be submitted to signify the intentions of the resident graduate to take the Clinical Written Exam.

If an application form was already accomplished during the Written Basic Examination, the candidate need NOT submit another application form.

- The PBA must receive the application form on or before **March 23, 2026**.

- **General Conditions**

- It is a MUST to pass the Clinical Written Exam. Each applicant will be given three (3) attempts to pass the Clinical Written Exam.
- Applicants who fail the Clinical Written Exam three (3) times shall need to:
 - take the next RITE prior to application to sit for the next Clinical Written Exam
- In order to qualify for the Oral Examination, the applicant must have passed both the Basic and Clinical Written Examinations.
